The Elite Division is intended exclusively for players who are current, former (and in rare cases future) college lacrosse players. This league features the highest level of play in Michigan. Established teams have already been determined (see registration form). Other players may also sign up for a "house" spot. Even if your team is listed below - make certain to register. Don't lose your spot. Your games are on Tuesdays or Wednesdays

each week and to accommodate work schedules, they begin no earlier than 7:30 PM. There will also be a trainer on staff at all times during elite games.

You must register individually to participate - even if you are playing on an established team. Check our web site for more information.



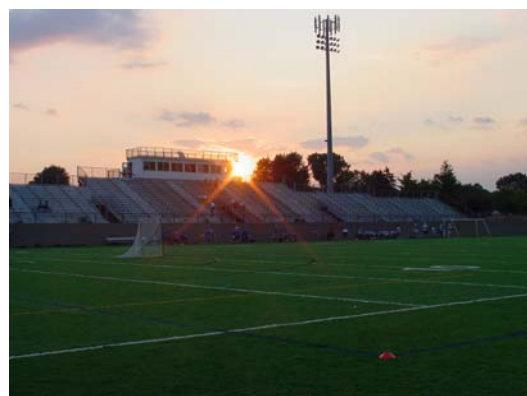

WOMEN'S DIVISION

The Women's Division is new for 2003. This program is for women who are current and former college and club players along with outstanding high school players (at the discretion of the league directors). To maintain a safe and appropriate environment, the league directors reserve the right to move players down to the JV level if they are not ready for this program. Most players are

returning varsity athletes or former JV players who are certain to move up. The league will provide each team with a coach who is a current or former college player. You will play one game each week. The day of the week will vary (Monday through Thursday).

Most players will be incoming freshman or sophomores who played middle school or JV during the spring of 2003. The league will provide each team with a coach who is a current or former college player.

You will play one game each week, and the day of the week will vary (Monday through Thursday). Please note there are no games during July 4th week.
